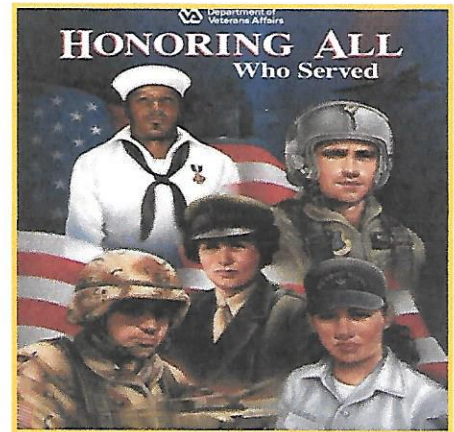


SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERAN FAMILIES (SSVF)



The SSVF Program is designed to improve the housing stability of very low-income Veteran families, by assisting families transitioning from homelessness to permanent housing and preventing at-risk families from becoming homeless.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ◆ Must be a veteran or a member of a family in which the head of household, or the spouse of the head of household is a Veteran
- ◆ Very-low income: household income can not exceed 50% of the area median income.
- ◆ Occupying permanent housing in one of three categories:
Residing in permanent housing, homeless and scheduled to become a resident of permanent housing within 90 days, or has exited permanent housing within the previous 90 days to seek other housing that is responsive to the very-low income Veteran family's needs and preferences.

In Calhoun, Clay, Kanawha, McDowell, Mingo, and Roane counties, Coalfield CAP, Inc, will provide eligible families with outreach, case management and assistance obtaining VA and other benefits, which may include:

- ◆ Health Care Services
- ◆ Daily Living Services
- ◆ Child Care Services
- ◆ Transportation Services
- ◆ Temporary Financial Assistance
- ◆ Fiduciary & Payee Service
- ◆ Legal Service
- ◆ Personal Financial Planning Services
- ◆ Housing Counseling Services
